Greetings..!!!

It gives us immense pleasure to inform you that the school is organizing an 'Educational tour to the Dragon country – Bhutan' from 12th to 18th December 2016 for the boarders of Class XI. Students will be taken to Kaharbandi Gompa of Phuntsoling, Buddha Point (Kuensel Phodrang), King's Memorial Chorten and National Library of Thimphu, Drukgyel Dzong, Taktsang Monastery, Kyichu Lhakhang of Paro among many others.

Detail of the tour may be read as under:

- Tour cost per child: Rs.26, 000/- (Rupees Twenty Six Thousand only)
- Accommodation shall be in three-sharing basis and tour programme is subject to minimum confirmation of 25 students.
- Due to limited availability of seats selection of students will be on first come first serve basis.
- Excess amount (if any) will be credited to the individual bursary account of boarders and the same shall be notified to the parents through email.
- Separate male and female escort teachers will be deputed by the school.
